Andy Armstrong	Texas A&M University	<p>The first few groups, honors, athletes and students with disabilities, we flag separately. Graduates can register during the entire preregistration process. Undergraduate are divided by classification (U4, U3, U2 and U1). Within each group we allow those coded as student workers the ability to register on the last day of the previous classification. For example, U3 student workers may register on the last day of U4s.</p> <p>The entire process takes about 21 days depending on holidays. The registration system is open 24 hours during preregistration, closed on holidays and weekends.</p>
Elizabeth Samuel	UT-Dallas	Registration is by hours earned at DCCCD. Priority Registration started June 17 and is for credit students currently enrolled in Summer 2008, or earned a letter grade in Spring 08 or Fall 07. Regular Registration starts June 23. This is for all admitted students.
Carey Rose	Temple College	<p>Web Registration – 1 month for returning students only</p> <p>Advantage Registration – New and returning students</p> <p>Regular Registration – New and returning students</p> <p>Late Registration- New and returning students & and a late Registration fee is assessed.</p>
website	Collin County Community College	Regarding fall registration: Is by hours earned at CCCC. Students with 10 hours and above register June 24-26. New students and students under 10 hours start June 27.
website	Dallas County	Regarding fall registration: Is by hours earned at DCCCD. Priority Registration started June 17 and is for credit students currently enrolled in Summer 2008,

	Community College District	or earned a letter grade in Spring 08 or Fall 07. Regular Registration starts June 23. This is for all admitted students.
website	Tarrant County College	Most students are allowed to register at any time during scheduled registration periods; however, the College may assign specific registration times as needed to offer optimum system performance.
website	Texas A & M Commerce University	Freshmen began registering March-April. This was done by classification. New Students register through orientation sessions – June through August.
website	Texas Tech University	Regarding fall registration: Advance Registration for currently enrolled students April 1-16. This was done by classification. Former Tech students register April 16. Open Registration starts April 17. This looked like only for current and former students. New Freshman and Transfer Students started May 27.
Richard Jimmerson	University of Texas at Arlington	Priority registration for Athletes, Honors College students, graduating seniors. The priority is then prorated by dates in the order of cumulative semester credit hours in ranges for continuing students down to students on probation. New students register during the open registration period.
Bobbie Fry	University of the Incarnate Word	Priority for athletes, then seniors and graduate students, then juniors, then all others.
