

SETACRAO – Southeast Texas Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers

The Southeast Texas Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (SETACRAO) includes a geographic area that begins at the Brazos River and extends south to Houston and the Gulf Coast. There are no membership dues, but a small registration fee is usually charged at each meeting to cover expenses. Meetings are held twice per year with meeting locations rotating among area schools. One hundred to one hundred-fifty professional and support staff attend each meeting. The purpose of the association is to promote professional and staff development, to respond to legislation affecting higher education, and to develop and promote inter/intra institutional cooperation in student services.
