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At the 2018 TACRAO Conference the High School Relations met to discuss the schedule for the 2019-2020 season. We discussed the amount of authority the committee members have in determining what schools can have what times for events due to low attendance and not adhering to implementing the TACRAO rules. We were guided that we have the authority to move schools to different times if needed. We chose to begin to give warnings to schools scheduled for night fairs letting them know that if their student attendance did not increase we will have to schedule them for a morning or afternoon event.

We notified the HS counselors by email when we sent the preliminary event schedule to each HS event facilitator letting them know that we will not be utilizing the FairPlanner system. We suggested that they utilize some version of online registration gathering such as Eventbrite or google forms. We offered to help any High School create a registration form and show them how to use Eventbrite or google forms.
