TACRAO Membership Engagement Ad-Hoc Report

November 2025

Purpose of Committee

Charge of the Committee: The Ad-Hoc Membership Engagement Advisory will be convened for one calendar year beginning in March 2025 to examine trends and challenges surrounding member engagement and make recommendations to the TACRAO Executive Committee on tactics and strategies to have long-term positive impacts in this critical space. Considerations should include but are not limited to:

- Establishment of a permanent Membership Engagement Officer
- Establishment of a Membership Engagement Standing Committee
- Creation of new programming or training that will increase and deepen member engagement
- Necessary investments in new materials, speakers, meetings, that may serve to maintain engagement opportunities between the annual conferences.

This Committee will make its first report to the TEC and Past President's Council at the annual conference in El Paso on November 9-12, 2025. They will take feedback from that presentation along with other input gathered after the conference for a final presentation and recommendations to the TEC at their March 2026 meeting.

Ad-Hoc Committee Information

This committee will be made up of the following individuals to ensure broad and informed perspectives.

- Two (2) Members of the TEC (in 2025: Jennifer Beal and Bobbie Brown)
- Two (2) Members who have joined TACRAO within the last three (3) years
 Two (2) Members with more than Five (5) years of experience in TACRAO

Ideas for Membership Engagement from March and May 2025 Meetings:

- Develop a new member onboarding. This may include:
 - Webinars
 - o Pre-recorded videos sent via email
 - Welcome email once added to an institution roster
 - Incorporate website info
 - Create a discussion post for new members
 - TACRAO resources

- Provide training to new members throughout the first year of membership (webinars).
- Present at the Annual conference and for those that cannot go to the conference, provide presentations via webinars.
- Andrew indicated he'd like to see us bring back Mentors. Assign a mentor when person joins so it's not just at the conference. Have clear guidelines for Mentor and Mentee expectations.

Recommendations

- Recruit a new set of ad-hoc committee members
- Meet virtually with committee members with a clear goal for each meeting addressing two types of members:
 - New Members
 - Seasoned Members
- Create a summer session/webinar for new members (if virtual) and new member session if in person.
- Create a TACRAO Annual conference session for Membership Engagement.
- Once membership database is cleaned, begin communication to new members:
 - Welcome Email to New Members
 - New member discussion forum invitation
 - New member training (webinar)
- Monthly communication to membership
