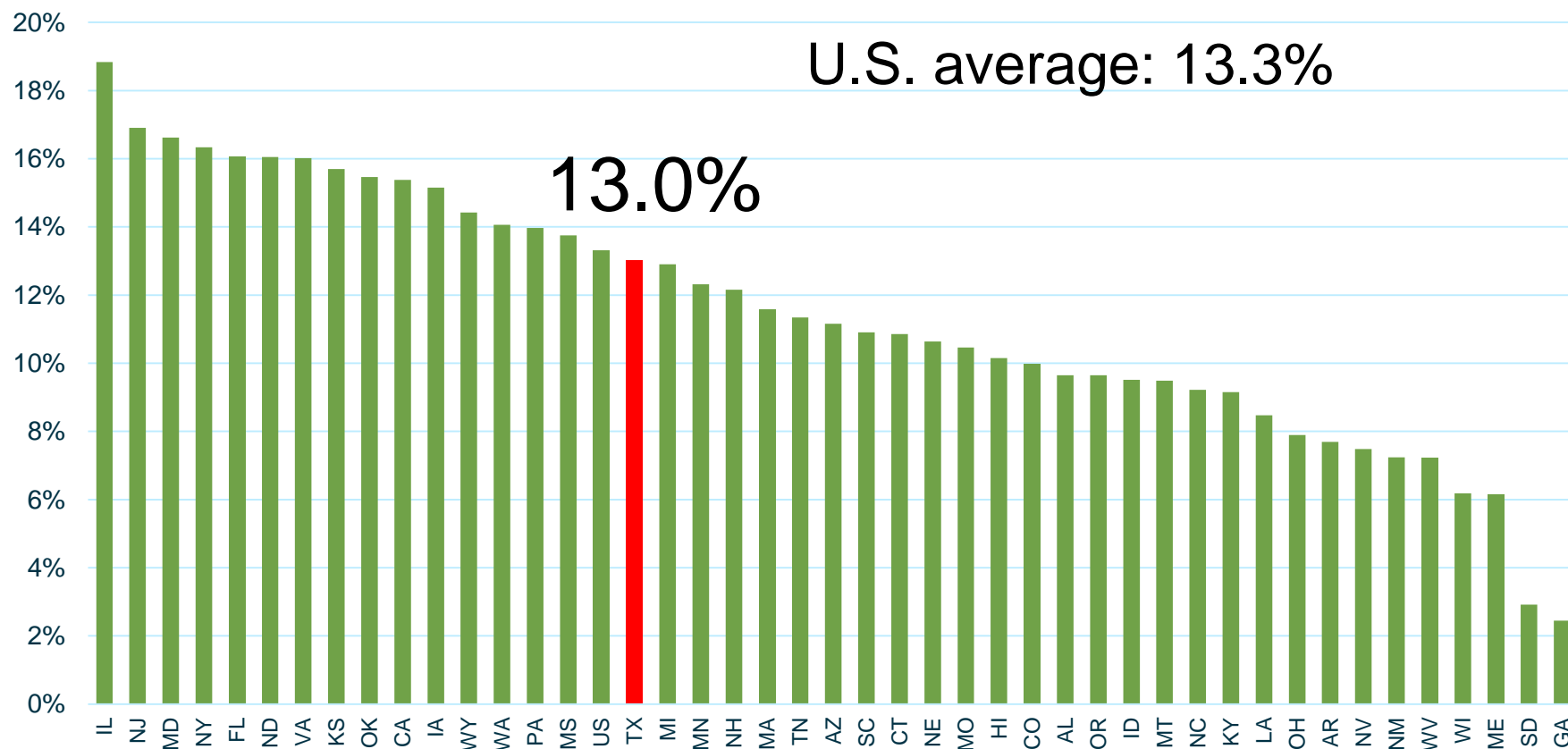

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What is Reverse Transfer?



Through Reverse Transfer, four- or two-year institutions can securely send course and grade information to any two-year institution from which a student has transferred. If eligible, the student is then awarded an associate degree.

It doesn't matter if the student transferred to another associate degree-granting institution first or a bachelor's-level institution, attended public or private institutions, or transferred across state lines.

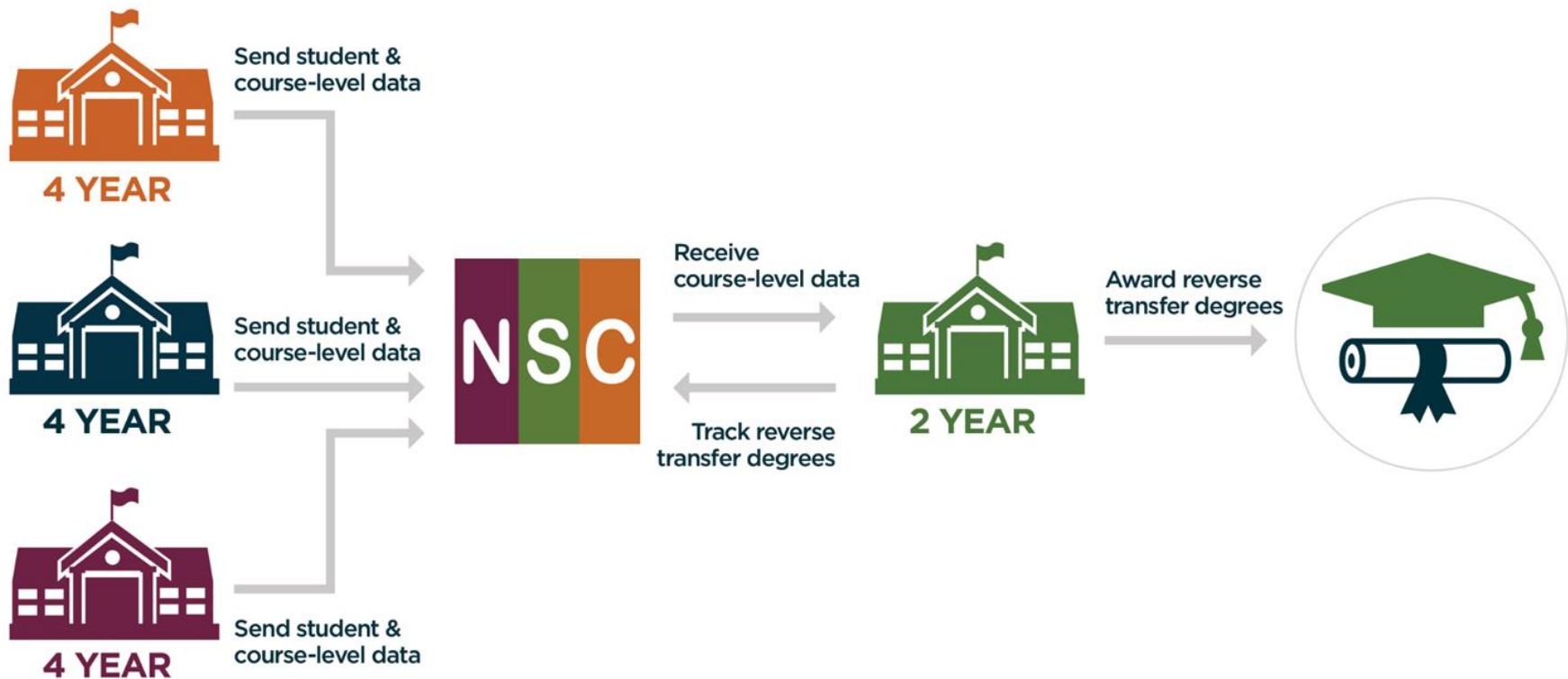

- Utilizes PESC TS 130 Transcript standards

File Features

- Process filters out student records for associate degrees
- Customize data filters for receiving students such as credits earned
- Identification of courses that are part of general education requirements
- A flag to indicate a student has completed the core courses
- Updated student contact information
